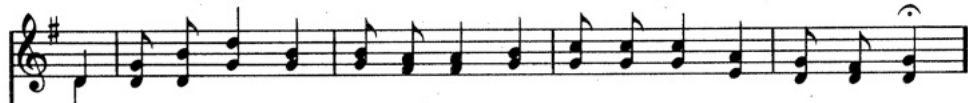
# The Solid Rock
