REGENT SQUARE

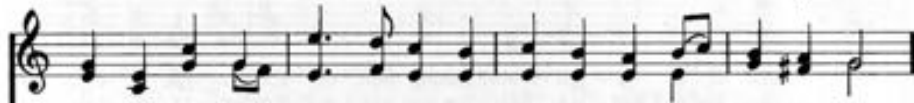
