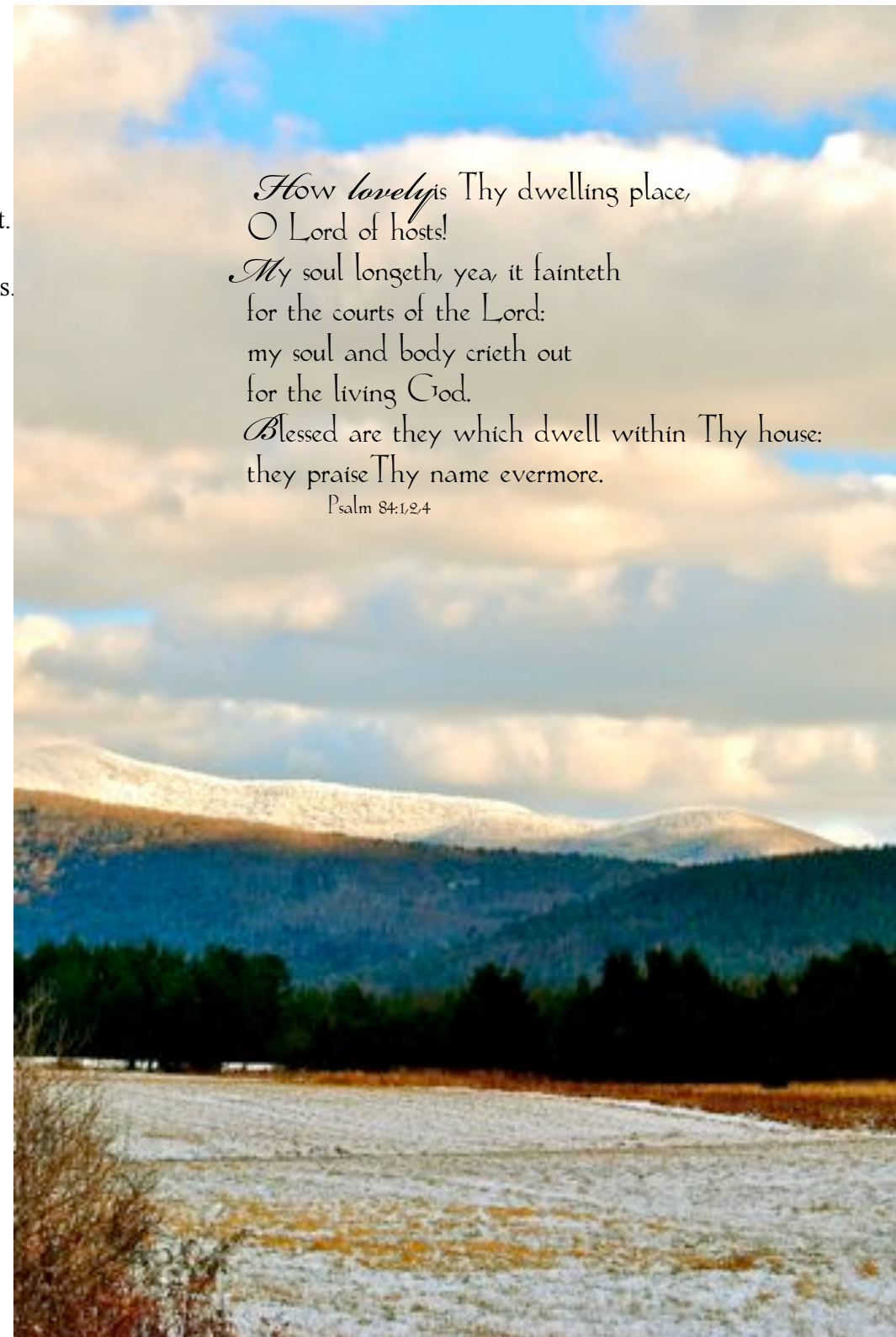


We have seen the God of glory
