First Sunday in Lent



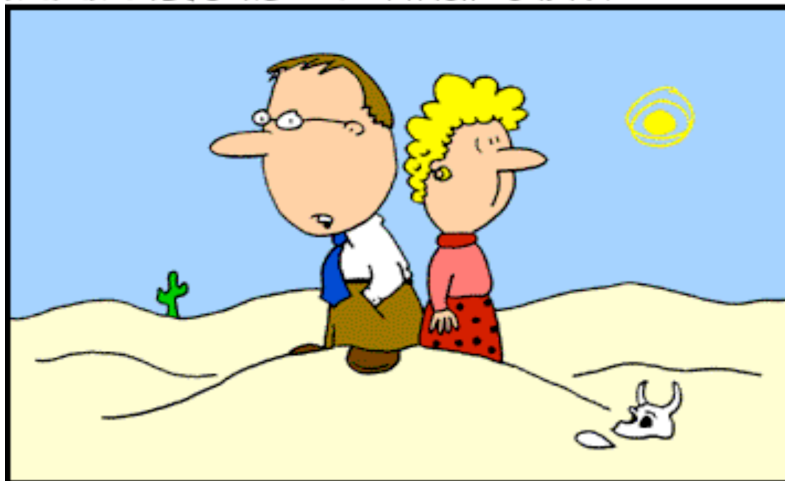
