Our Heritage Meditation Questions from Class Meetings/Soul Clinics

During this pre-Easter Season, we are going back to our roots in the Wesley brothers, John and Charles, who in the 1700s led a movement to "spread scriptural holiness over the land." These questions are taken from the small accountability groups in the Methodist movement, known as "class meetings." In later years, there were also "soul clinics," where the questions were asked to the group rather than to individual persons.

More thought-provoking questions:

Am I walking in the light God shines on my way?

"If we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship one with another, and the blood of Jesus Christ his Son cleanseth us from all sin." I John 1:7

Am I progressing in my walk with God?

"Ye were sometimes darkness, but now are ye light in the Lord: walk as children of light" Ephrsians 5:8

Have I desire for a fuller fellowship with the Savior?

"That I may know him, and the power of his resurrection, and the fellowship of his sufferings, being made conformable unto his death" Philippians 3:10

Have I an increase in mercy, compassion, humbleness of mind? "Fulfil ye my joy, that ye be likeminded, having the same love, being of one accord, of one mind. Let nothing be done through strife or vainglory; but in lowliness of mind let each esteem other better than themselves." Philippians 2:2-3

Do I have an increase in faith and labor of love?
