An outline of John Wesley's sermon "The Use Of Money"

The right use of money.

Money is not evil; it is the *love* of money which the root of all evil. Money is an excellent gift from God.

Three axioms concerning money:

I. Gain all you can. Without:

- A. hurting your life or your health
- B. hurting your mind (soul) No sinful trade, nor any activity which is illegal.
- C. hurting your neighbor.
 - 1. in his substance.
 - 2. in his body.
 - 3. in his soul.

Gain all you can. By:

- D. honest industry. Don't delay or waste time.
- E. common sense.

II. Save all you can

Don't waste money:

- A. in the gratification of creature comforts.
- B. in superfluous adornments.
- C. in gratification of the pride of life to impress others.
- D. on your children
 - 1. by buying them costly apparel, or indulging their senses.
 - 2. by leaving them an inheritance that they will squander.


III. Give all you can.
