Grant me, most merciful Father, an unshakable faith, a hope no less strong, and a ceaseless love.

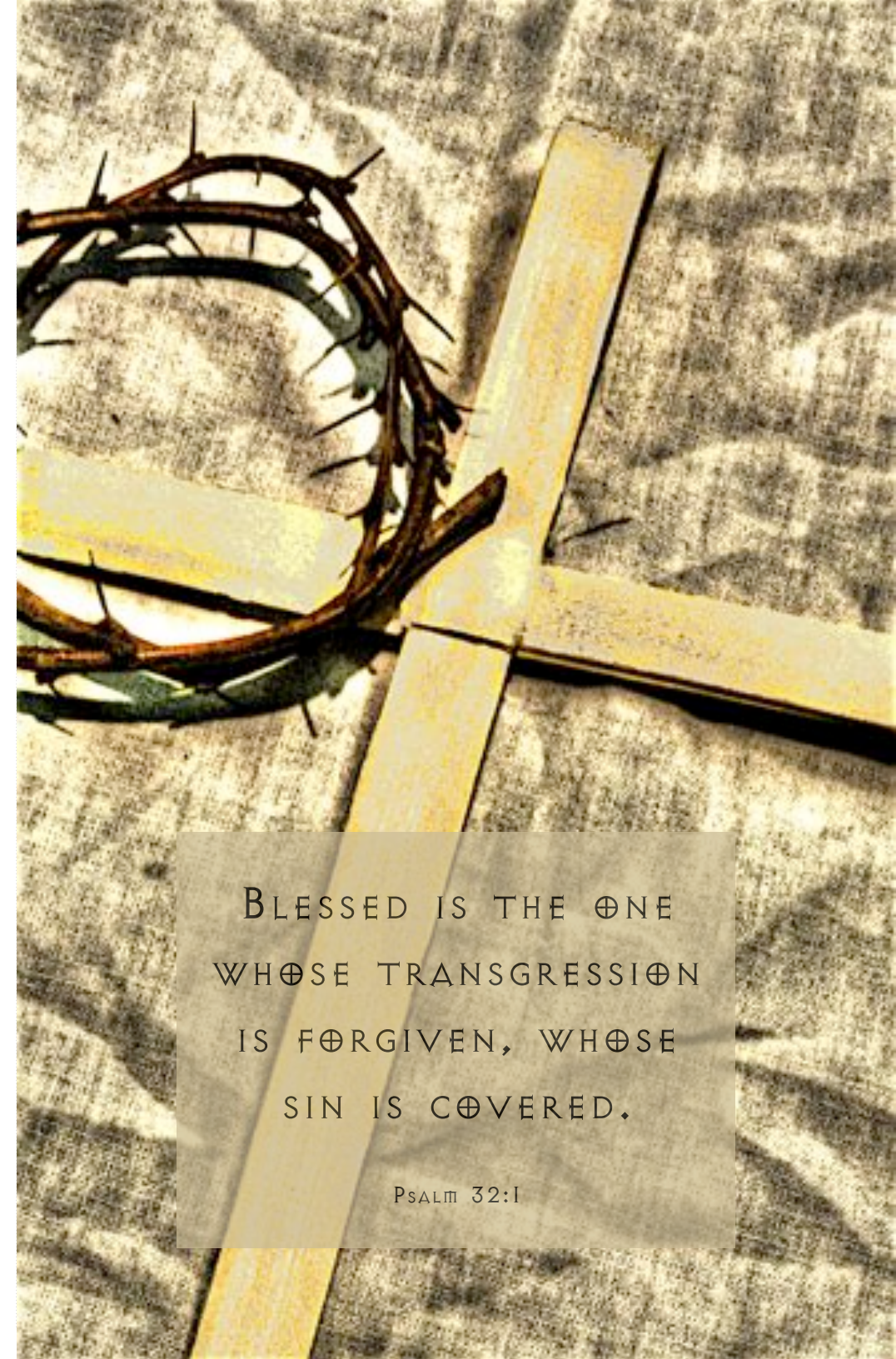
