God may or may not send revival to our nation or our town, but you can experience personal revival.


As a young man Evan Roberts experienced the presence of God in powerful ways. One night he was awakened from his sleep and led into a deep communion with God that lasted for hours. This experience was to continue every evening for the next few months and did not stop until he went away to the school. Attending a conference while away at school, he prayed, "Bend me O Lord." He would go home from school to share with the youth group of his home church four steps to getting right with God:

- 1. Confess all known sin
- 2. Deal with and get rid of anything 'doubtful' in your life
- 3. Be ready to obey the Holy Spirit instantly
- 4. Confess Christ publicly

The message spread widely as thousands accepted this message and put it into practice during the Welsh Revival. This message is not limited to the early 1900's and the promise of revival is available to you
