This morning before I went to jail [service], as I was praying, the song "Thank you Lord for saving my soul" came to my mind. As I started singing that song God spoke to me. "I answered your prayer that you would live long enough to take care of Virginia."

Then I broke down and started weeping, as God revealed to me that it [had been] time for her to go home; she had suffered and been through enough. She had given all [to the Lord]. I had prayed many times over the years. as doctors and others told me that caregivers go down more often than the loved one. I didn't want her in a nursing home. "Keep me alive and healthy enough to take care of her" was my constant prayer. (I understand that a nursing home has to be the case sometimes, but I wasn't persuaded to put her in a nursing home.)

I started thanking God for answering my prayer. The healing that it brought was very deep; I wept harder and longer than I had in months. My heart is lighter now and the hurt is easier than it has been. Thank you, Lord, for answering my prayer.
