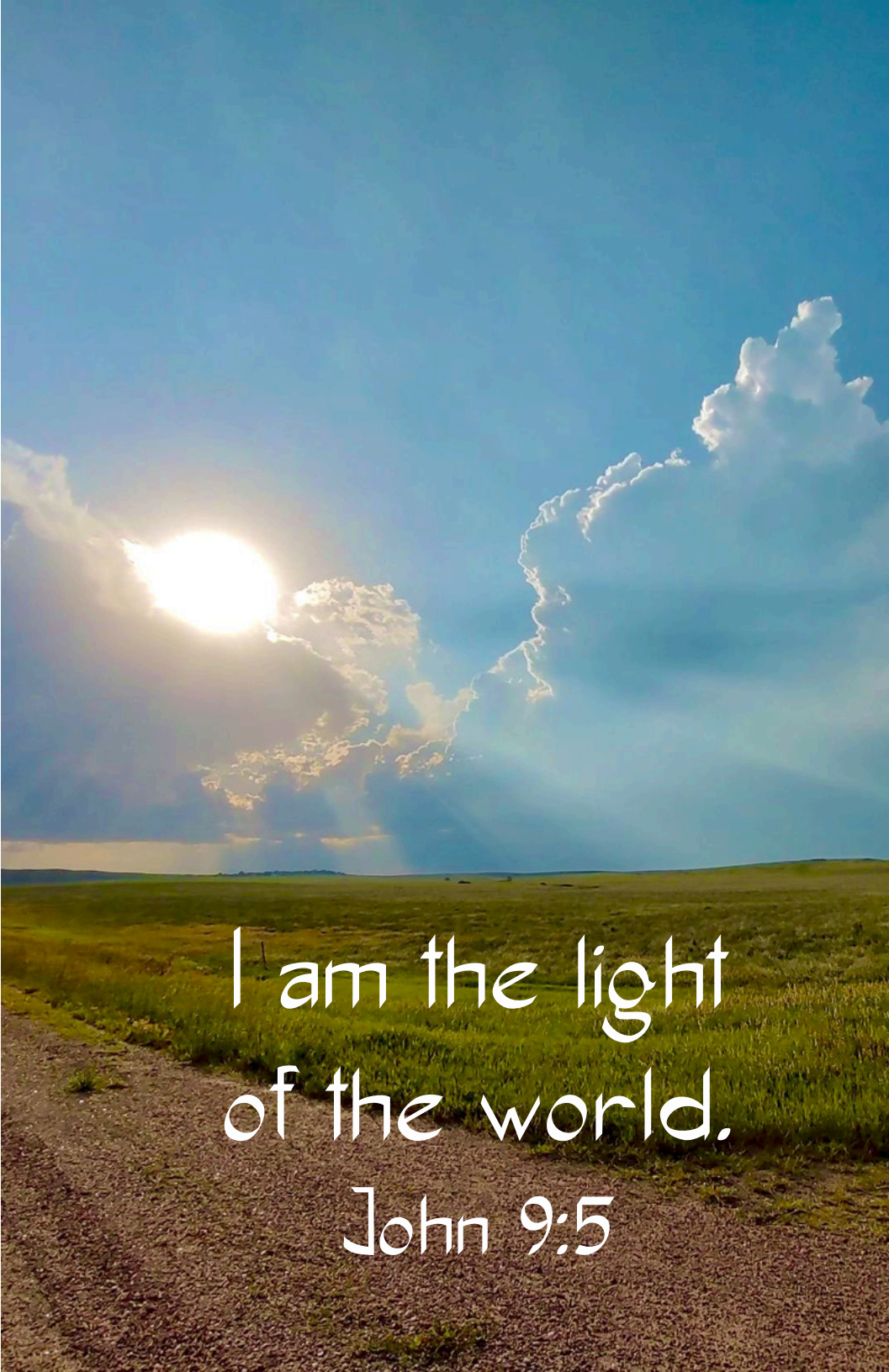
We walk every day through the darkness of this world,






