Augustine then realized that he had been trying to put an infinite God into his finite mind.

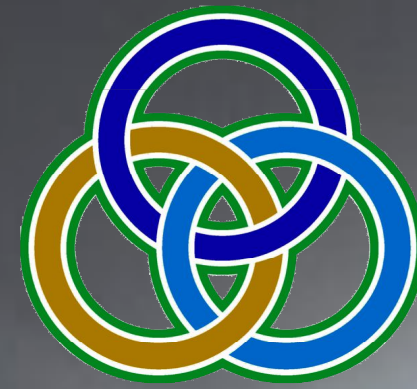
Bring me a worm that can comprehend a man, and then I will show you a man that can comprehend the Triune God.
