Than on the day we first begun.*

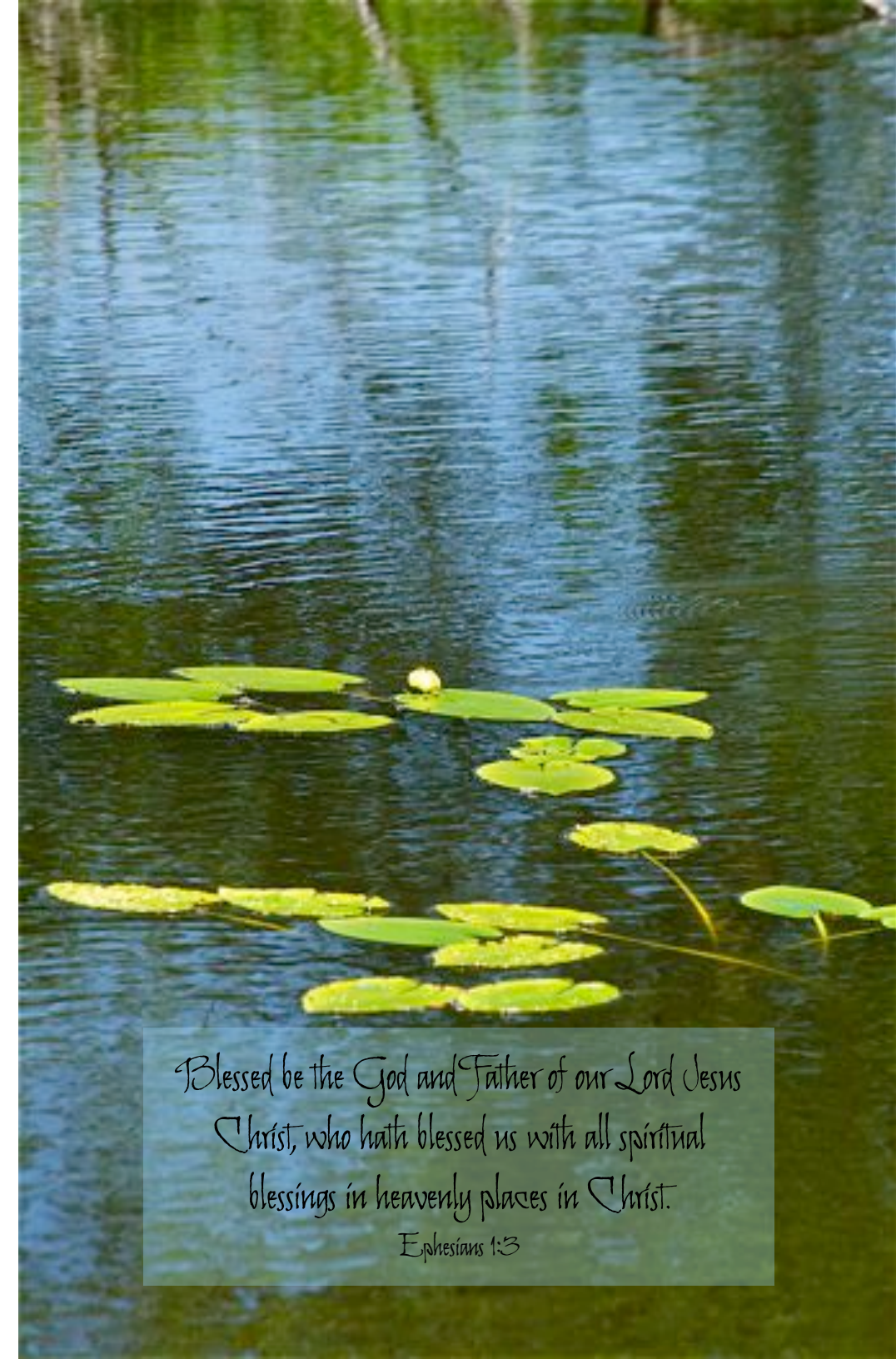
