Isaiah 58:12*

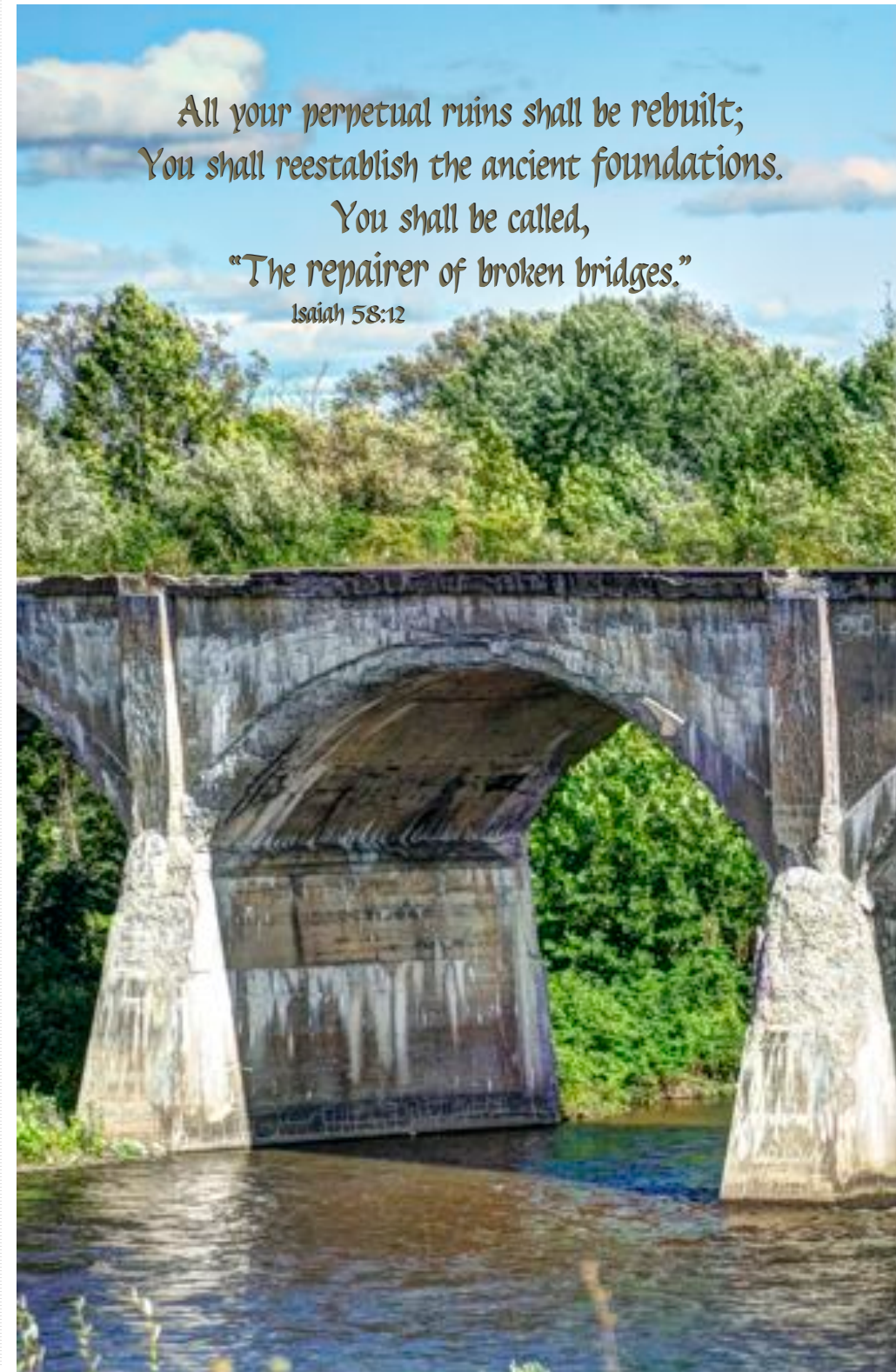
