Builds on the Rock that naught can move.

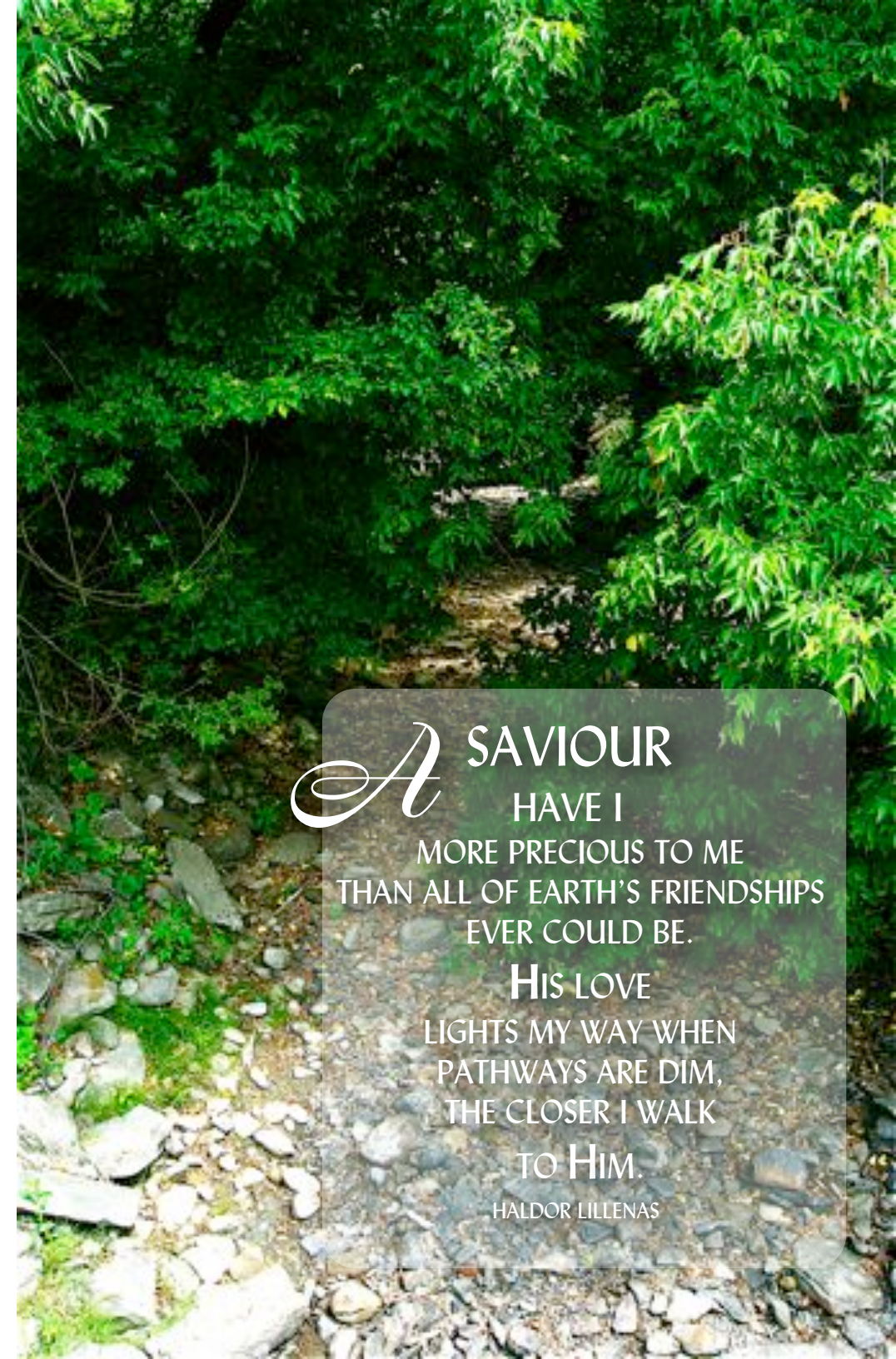
Only be still, and wait His leisure
