A MESSAGE FROM PASTOR DANI:

In 1932, our church turned 56 years old. It was also during that year that the women of our church started a potluck dinner on the first Sunday of every month, now known as "Dinner Day."

Let me give you an idea of what life was like in 1932:

The world-famous Radio City Music Hall first opened in Rockefeller Center in New York City. Amelia Earhart became the first woman to fly solo across the Atlantic ocean in May, and later in August she became the first woman to fly from coast to coast (California to New Jersey). In 1932, the United States was in its third year of the Great Depression and in October the New York Yankees beat the Chicago Cubs in the baseball World Series, with Babe Ruth playing for the Yankees. And finally, in December of 1932, Rosa Louise McCauley married Raymond Parks (and she became Rosa Parks), which occurred 23 years before Rosa's arrest began the year-long Montgomery Bus Boycott.

Can you take a moment to ponder how much our world has changed in these last 90 years?


Since the beginning of Dinner Day in 1932, we've been through 16 US presidencies (including a presidential assassination), the Second World War, the Cold War and the start of the War against Terrorism. We witnessed the first man walk on the moon, the end of racial segregation's legality, and the invention of the internet and hybrid cars. We've also survived almost two years of a global pandemic.

So much has changed since that first shared meal called "Dinner Day" at our church in 1932. But a few things remain.

Community has remained. Holy conversations that begin by sharing a meal remain. The church we call "home" remains. And most importantly, the love of God remains.

Even when we change or the world around us changes, some things just stay the same. We go through ups and downs throughout our lives, but the security of what doesn't change brings us comfort in all seasons. The importance of a shared meal with friends and experiencing the love of God in sharing the same table – that has remained. Thanks be to God for our amazing church and traditions like Dinner Day that keep on sustaining our faith throughout the ups and downs of our lives. Happy 90 years of this incredible Ivy tradition!


