A MESSAGE FROM PASTOR DANI:

In her book titled *Help. Thanks. Wow. The Three Essential Prayers*, Anne Lamott writes about how to navigate life with consistent prayer. These prayers help us navigate the difficult moments in life where we're overwhelmed as well as the celebratory moments where we are filled with gratitude. And since I read this book for the first time in 2013, I've used it for the last several years to help me navigate the highs and lows that accompany life. And I've said these three prayers throughout the last 912 days that I have had the privilege of serving as pastor at Ivy Centennial United Methodist Church.

The prayer "Help": Over the last 2 ½ years at Ivy "help" has been a constant prayer of mine. I prayed for all the help I could receive when the world changed in March 2020, and we shut the doors of the church. I know for certain that one of the ways my prayers were answered was by your presence and love. Our ministries changed overnight as we hosted worship online and outdoors, as we painted rocks and delivered them to each other's houses, as we delivered packages to each other, and more. We quickly learned that what it means to be "a church" isn't just about gathering in a building – but living as the hands and feet of Christ. You were the answer to my prayer: "help."

The prayer "Thanks": I said this prayer more frequently than I prayed for *help*. Thank you, God, for the delicious food and the kind fellowship that we share on Dinner Day. Thank you, God, for the fun we have at church game nights. Thank you, God, for the lives we remember on All Saints Sunday and at funerals. Thank you, God, for the babies and teenagers we baptized and confirmed over the last 912 days. Thank you, God, for the best cinnamon rolls I've ever eaten which I ate for the first time at Ivy. Thank you, God, for the committee leaders who have helped me make difficult decisions about masks, the church building, worship, returning to fellowship, and more. Thank you, God, for the people who make up Ivy Centennial UMC.

The prayer "Wow": With the prayers I've offered in awe over the last few years, I've always found Ivy at the center. When we celebrated Christmas for the first time in person together in 2021, I kept praying: Wow! When we had new lights installed in the church parking lot and people kept telling me how incredible the church looked at night when they drove on HWY 163, I prayed: Wow! Even new parking lot lights bring glory to God. When we hosted the best Vacation Bible School ever in the summer of 2021, I thought Wow! God has so much in store for us. Wow. Look at how faithful God has been with us and for us.

These are the best prayers I've had for you, with you, and because of your love for the last 2 ½ years. Help. Thanks. And Wow! Amen.
