JOHN C. MAXWELL

I love John Maxwell. His influence in my life is immeasurable. He was listed as the *"#1 Most Influential Business Leader"* by the American Business Association. He is brilliant and he is a great leader. But most of all, John was my Pastor in San Diego many years ago. One of my all-time favorite quotes is from a book review:

"The second law of John C. Maxwell's book, 'The 21 Irrefutable Laws of Leadership' should be required learning for everyone in high school. It is the Law of Influence which says, 'The true measure of leadership is influence – nothing more, nothing less.' If you do not learn this law early, you will learn it the hard way.'"

The reason why I mention this insight about influence is simply because I want you to know that as a believer, you have influence, you are a person of influence, and our God would have you use your influence for Him. How we use that influence says a lot about our own character, and more, how we truly feel and are committed to following Jesus Christ. Thus, you have the underlying motivation for the D2D classes that are starting up again this month.

We can learn together to be people who use our great influence for Christ by being grounded in the Bible, knowing how to share our story about how we came to know Christ, and then being able to explain in a very simple, clear and effective way what it takes to become a Christian. We can definitely make a huge difference not only on others who are in and around our lives, but also in ourselves. The other side of the coin concerning being mentored to be a disciple and a person of influence, is then we are adequately prepared to be a disciple that can use our knowledge and influence to equip others to be the same. D2D is really just a big lesson on influence—and like Maxwell said, nothing more, nothing less. Course Outline

The three books are designed to be completed in sequence. Book 2 builds on the work done in book 1. Book 3 builds on what your group has accomplished in the first two books. You will enjoy each book's biblical and practical approach to discipleship. As many others have, those of you who participate in a 2:7 group

can expect to experience positive life changes as you study and apply this time-proven material Following is the main content of the three courses:

Book 1: Growing Strong in God's Family

In the first book in The 2:7 Series, you complete exercises that strengthen your spiritual foundation through enriching Bible study, Scripture memory and group interaction.

Book 2: Deepening Your Roots in God's Family

The discipleship training in this second book builds on the work done in the first book. You will learn ways to deepen your own Christian life, approaches for sharing your faith, and how to experience an extended time alone with God.

Book 3: Bearing Fruit in God's Family

You will continue to develop and strengthen your walk with Christ during this third book in the series. You discuss priorities and life management, learn a versatile tool for explaining the gospel, and sharpen your own salvation testimony.

ABOUT WILL GRAHAM:

Will Graham is the third generation of Grahams to proclaim the Gospel of Jesus Christ under the banner of the Billy Graham Evangelistic Association (BGEA). Will is the grandson of Billy Graham and the oldest son of Franklin Graham.

"This world is a broken place," Will said recently. "People are hurting, dealing with addictions, family issues, job and financial issues, or depression. So many are hopeless. I desperately want people to know that there is hope, and it's found in Christ." Since 2006, Will has been telling people about that hope through events called Celebrations. He's had the privilege of preaching all over the world, on every continent except Antarctica.

Will is an ordained minister who serves as vice-president of the BGEA. He's also executive director of the Billy Graham Training Center at The Cove, a spiritual retreat center in the mountains of North Carolina. He and his wife Kendra live near Asheville, North Carolina, with their three children.

WHAT IS A CELEBRATION?

Since 1950 the Billy Graham Evangelistic Association has held Crusades all across the globe for one purpose: to proclaim God's love to people who need Jesus Christ. Today, Will Graham Celebrations continue this life-changing mission.

THE MESSAGE AND THE GOAL:

→ 1) To mobilize the Christian community to gather as many people as possible to hear the message that *Jesus Christ is "the way, the truth, and the life"* (John 14:6, NKJV).
2) To give people an opportunity to make a personal commitment to Jesus Christ.
3) To refer inquiries to a local church for follow-up and Christian nurture.
4) To strengthen the local church.

THE METHOD:

→ A Will Graham Celebration is much larger than the few days of the actual event. While the evangelistic services are the most visible aspect, they are not the only part. It all begins with local Christians praying and working behind the scenes to prepare the way. Long after the event is over, area churches carry on the work, discipling those who came to faith during the Celebration.
