





#### MISSION & OUTREACH UPDATE

On Nov 10, three of the members from M/O delivered items collected for Embrace. Response this year by the congregation was phenomenal. There were four totes full of blankets, towels, and personal beauty products. Laundry baskets had paper products and art and



craft supplies. We were able to cross off many items from Embrace's wish list.

Names and wish lists for the Adopt-A-Family project have been received and ornaments with gift suggestions are now on the tree.

#### Haiti's Children (HCI) Update

I received a letter from Gladys Mungo a short time ago and thought I would share her news from Haiti. Trinity sponsored a child through her organization Haiti's Children Inc. (HCI)

Gladys had a busy summer talking at 21 different services to diverse groups including "Revelation Riders" and "Recycled Teenagers." This resulted in finding sponsors for 41 more children. Her message to us was about spreading God's word ....Spreading the Seed. From "Seeds of Hope" sales, \$4000 was made along with 1,800 seed packets to take back to take back to Haiti for planting!

When Gladys returned to Haiti it was one month later than usual due to having shoulder surgery. Gladys endured many other delays returning caused by the devastation from Hurricane Irma. With the help of Agape Flights they were able to get the remaining tarps they had on hand, to Puerto Rico after Hurricane Maria hit there. Luckily the area where

Gladys is from, didn't receive hurricane damage this year.

In 2016 Haiti was hard hit by Hurricane Matthew. Returning in the fall of 2017 there were still issues that continued as the results of Matthew. HCI received a grant to help supply materials for 100 roofs. HCI was aifted with not one but two 40' containers of food from Feed My Starving Children (FMSC) 544 320 meals! Water and rice was received from Convoy of Hope. Funds came in to purchase spaghetti, mackerel, and other staple products. Over 100 tons of food have been delivered to villages where HCI works. Churches from Illinois. Wisconsin, Washington and Minnesota stepped up and immediately sent tarps, food, and hygiene kits to get out to peo-

There are always ways for us to help support Gladys' mission in Haiti.




