- ONE light-weight bath-size towel (52" x 27"), dark color recommended
- TWO bath-size bars of soap equaling 8 to 9 oz., any brand, in original wrapping

Don't enclose Kit or any of its contents in plastic bags. Fold the towel in half. Place the rest of the items in the towel, fold and roll so nothing falls out, and secure with yarn, ribbon, string or rubber bands.
