## TRINITY VOTES TO CALL PASTOR JACK JORGENSEN



Trinity's congregation voted unanimously to extend a letter of call to Pastor Jack Jorgensen at a Special Congregational Meeting, December 3. Pastor Jack will start February 6, as he will be on a mission trip to India from January 4-20. Interim Pastor Lauren Ley's contract is through January 31.

Pastor Jack recently served as Interim Pastor at Trinity Lutheran Church in Hudson, WI. He had also served as the Director of Youth Ministry there. Previously, he taught 6-8th grade in White Bear Lake, MN (2012-2014), and taught 7th-8th grade science in St. Paul, MN (1996-2011). Pastor Jack also served in the U.S. Army as a Combat Field Medic (1987-1993).

He earned a Bachelor of Science in Education from the University of River Falls, WI, a Master of Divinity from The Master's Institute Seminary, White Bear Lake, MN, and was ordained through the International Ministerial Fellowship.

We look forward to Pastor Jack's arrival and are grateful for Pastor Lauren's shepherding hand during the past several months. God is Good!

"I'm currently available to begin a new position of serving. In humility and dedicated service, I seek to shepherd a congregation. I hope to continue leading others of all ages in closer relationship with our Savior Jesus Christ through reading His word, living a life that reflects His teaching, and sharing the Gospel with all who are willing to listen. New electrical outlets need to be installed to shorten the temporary power cables. But it was wonderful to project videos and slides on the two far walls without the center screen.


Plus, Pastor LOVED being able to have his own view of things off the back wall!
