This event is SO much fun! Plus we get to eat any that aren't quite perfect! Anyone is welcome to come and lend a helping hand! No prior experience needed — we'll teach you!

You can buy the lefse on December 3, before and after the worship service.



What is LEFSE?

It is a round flatbread of Norwegian origin, traditionally made of a potato-based dough and baked on a griddle. (Think of it as a Norwegian tortilla!) Many spread butter on it and roll it up; others sprinkle sugar on it before rolling it up. Either way, it's YUMMY!



About 70 people attended the *Community Awakening* presentation about recognizing drug use and addiction in our community. Barron County Sheriff Chris Fitzgerald gave an eye-opening session, *In Plain Sight*, in which he showed some of the devices used to hide drugs or drug paraphenalia: fake water bottles, fake hair brushes, and even a highlighter. Trinity's giving got kicked into high gear. We even found a brand new winter coat for the grandma!


There are no words to describe the love and pride that swells my heart every year for the overwhelming generosity that Trinity shows for this project!!




High School Musical will be presented at Birchwood School with Jayda Glenz and Lucas Lehnert in the lead roles. This all-school play features students from elementary through high school.
