Qualifications

CITs are to at least 16 years old and a minimum of 2 years older than oldest camper at the camp you are serving.

Each applicant will need to complete the Application Form and submit recommendations from two adults – pastor, church leader, teacher, professor, etc.

Task Description

- 1. CIT's will assist Senior Counselor in overseeing a group of up to seven youth assigned to your cabin during camps, both on location at the campgrounds and during field trips away from the campground.
- 2. Strive to be a spiritual leader for all campers and praying for those in your cabin daily.
- 3. Participate in chapel discussion times and cabin devotions.
- 4. Be present and on time to all camping related activities.
- 5. Assist Senior Counselor with having your campers on time to all camping activities.
- 6. Spend quality time with your campers in an effort to meet their needs, challenge them to make or affirm a full commitment to Jesus Christ, and guide them in their overall development.
- 7. Create an atmosphere of love, safety, and growth for your campers, seeking to ensure that each one realizes a positive camping experience.
- 8. Be accountable to the camp director and senior counselor.
- 9. Support, assist, interact with, and pray for other CIT's, senior counselors and staff persons, making every effort to contribute to a spirit of complete unity on the part of the entire leadership team.
- 10. Be willing to assist with miscellaneous tasks, routine or unexpected, that need to be cared for in the common life of the camps cleaning, moving equipment, worship, programming, etc.
- 11. Be present at the staff meeting on Monday of your selected camp.
