# CAMP GUIDELINES

**The following guidelines will be enforced in the interest of safety and community.  
Thank you for your cooperation with these expectations 🙏**

1. Campers under 18 may not leave the campgrounds without parent/sponsor permission and may only leave after 7:00 p.m. if accompanied by a parent/sponsor.
2. Campers are not to ride bicycles after dark.
3. Campers are not to use bikes or skateboards on the Pavilion bridge or patio.
4. Parents and guardians should ensure children and youth are not together in private quarters without adult supervision.
5. Fighting, profanity, firearms (except for ceremonial purposes), fireworks, and the use of tobacco (including vaping), alcohol or illegal drugs, are not allowed at the camp.
6. Modesty and good taste in personal attire are expected while on the grounds. Shoes and shirts are required in the dining hall and the Pavilion.
7. Pavilion showers should not be used thirty minutes before or during services.
8. Campers are to attend the evening worship services. Those under the age of 18 are to attend youth or children's services, as age would dictate.
9. For the comfort of our campers, quiet hour begins at 11 p.m. OR 30 minutes after the last scheduled activity.
10. All pets on the campground must be confined or leashed. Campers are to care for pet waste promptly. Pets are not allowed in Indiana, Illinois, Bethany House, Heritage Lodge, Wesley Inn, or common buildings.
11. The disposal service requires that the refuse be placed in plastic bags before being deposited in the dumpsters.
12. Motorized vehicles such as 4-wheelers are not allowed. Golf carts are welcome for necessary transportation.

Wabash Park Camp & Retreat Center is a ministry of the Wabash Conference of the Free Methodist Church of North America. Rules for acceptance and participation in the program are the same for everyone without regard to race, color, sex, age, handicap, or national origin.

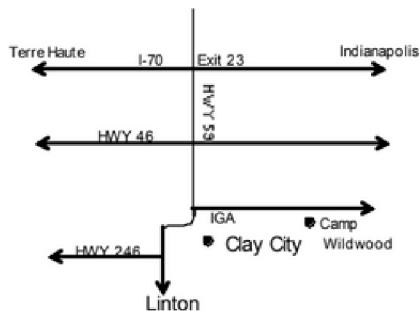
