

CAMPER CHECKLIST

Recommended list of what to pack:

- Sweatshirt, sweater or jacket
- Shorts & long pant
- Shirts (short & long sleeved)
- Rain gear
- Flashlight & batteries
- Sleeping bag & pillow or other bedding
- Bible, notebook & pen/pencil
- Bath & Beach Towels & washcloths
- Toiletries (toothbrush/paste, soap, shampoo, deodorant)
- Shower caddy
- Canteen money
- Swimming attire (one piece or cover)
- Flip Flops for pool & shower only
- Tennis shoes
- Underclothes
- Garbage bag for dirty clothes
- Bug repellent
- Sunscreen
- Refillable water bottle
- Garbage bag for wet clothing
- Medication in original containers
- Optional: camera & batteries

Other Important Information

- Registration for all camps will take place in the Pavilion and begins promptly at 3:00 PM on the first day of camp. Closing programs will take place in the Youth Chapel and begins at 11:00 AM on the last day of your camp.
- Bring all medication, canteen money, and cellphones to registration.
- Canteen funds will be placed on the camper's account and will track each purchase throughout the week. Unused canteen funds can be donated to our campership funds or returned to the camper. Just indicate your desire as you make your initial canteen deposit.
- Every effort will be made to ensure the safety and security of each camper at all times.
- Confirmation of registration will be sent to each camper upon receiving the registration form.
- DO NOT bring valuables, knives, fireworks, matches, lighters, offensive literature, or any electronic devices.
- There is to be no use of illegal drugs, tobacco or alcohol. Do not bring articles of clothing that are inappropriate in style, display inappropriate writing, pictures or symbols.
