#### From the Golf Course.....

Since late June rains have yielded 5 inches in 6 days, I thought I would explain what drives the decision to close the golf course to cart traffic (or close completely). My approach is very scientific. I get in a cart and drive around the golf course! If the cart tires are splashing water in the majority of the property, we do not allow carts out. There can be times when we limit carts to rough only when the rough has firmed up but fairways are still wet. I believe I would be considered "lenient" on allowing carts on the course following rains.

Maintenance staff often takes the time to place ropes, stakes and signs to divert cart traffic away from the wettest areas. At times it is just too wet and the damage to the course from cart or foot traffic can be detrimental. Low areas like those that intersect holes 13, 10 and 5 hold water. Some "wet" areas are surprising such as behind #11 green over to 12 tees?

Following Spring rains some of our higher areas on the property stay muddy but are dry following summer/autumn rains? #5 and #8 greens remain wet long after rains stop because they were constructed flush with the ground. Foot traffic on those wet greens causes harm. At times we close to carts but reevaluate in a few hours If the forecast shows drying conditions. We want golfers to enjoy the course.
