From the Board of Directors.....

For the past several years, Danville Country Club's expenses have outpaced its regular income. The board has worked hard to correct our financial deficiencies by removing the management company and implementing sound fiscal management. Although our financial situation has improved, we do not have sufficient resources to maintain all our current amenities and make future investments to maintain our facilities. We have relied on generous donations and voluntary assessments to cover the most urgent Club needs in the past. Our repair expenses club-wide continue to increase from deferred maintenance, and we have found it necessary to start a capital fund to prepare for future improvements.

The DCC Board of Directors has done their best to keep dues as low as possible, and The Club has been relying on volunteers to help maintain the property. In this last year alone, the Club received thousands of dollars in donated, discounted, or free labor and materials. This handful of members recognized the Club's needs and donated their time and resources. Relying solely on the goodwill of volunteers is not a sustainable model.

To ensure that DCC remains an integral part of our community and to maintain this great property, the board of directors has implemented a new dues structure with modest increases for most member classifications.

We have identified several capital projects that will need to be addressed in the not-so-distant future. To ensure we are prepared to make these investments in our Club, we are starting a monthly capital fee. The monthly capital fee will be as follows:

Golf	\$20.00
Social	\$10.00
Golf 30 - 40	\$10.00
Golf under 30	\$5.00
Social 30-40	\$5.00
Social under 30	\$5.00

2020 and 2021 members will be excluded from the monthly capital fee for the first two years of their membership.

These adjustments will begin May 1st.
