From the Golf Course Superintendent:

We are enjoying mild temperatures and the beauty of autumn. Our green grass provides a nice contrast to the array of leaf color out there. Our trees contribute so much to this property, but we understand the frustration of searching for a golf ball among the fallen leaves. This is the season when the maintenance staff focuses on leaf cleanup. We appreciate your patience as the leaves sometimes drop faster that we can manage them, or they blow back on to the surfaces that were just cleared off. We will soon winterize the irrigation system and other plumbing out on the property. We will likely remove the tee markers Nov.1 so they do not get lost in the leaf cleanup process. Cups will be changed less frequently as play diminishes. However, please continue to enjoy the golf course and do not forget to look up! Our golf course provides a useful "rest stop" for interesting, migrating birds.
