- We see the Body of Christ bringing hope for the hopeless, life to the dead, release for the captive and the unconditional love of Christ to our neighbors throughout the world.

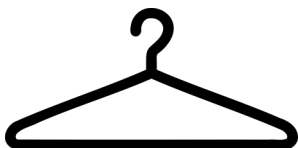
Our Values:

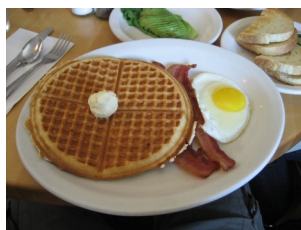
