These mission field areas tend to be resistant to the gospel, which means that the open proclamation of the gospel can be restricted, requiring creative approaches for ministry and missions; they may also be areas where the Church of the Nazarene is officially registered with the government, but whose political, social, or religious environment may not always be conducive to Christian outreach and church development.

THE UNNAMED are the missionaries and local church leaders whom God has called, and through whom God is working. They may be in areas not particularly welcoming or safe. Nonetheless, they are called to live out a worship-filled service in such a way as to be undeniably Christlike.
