Daily Prayer - Acts 3:1-12

Daily prayer allows us to have unique and extraordinary encounters with God. The passage in Acts 3 where Peter and John bless a man who was lame from birth is a clear example of one of these extraordinary encounters.

Perhaps Peter and John's plan was simply to go to the temple and pray as usual, but something was different that day. They were spiritually ready to take part of a miraculous event that God was about to perform in the life of a man in need.

This daily practice of prayer leads us to understand that spiritual life is not limited to one's self or to one particular place. It can lead us to serve others and helps us discern what are the most urgent and vital needs of those around us. Such was the case of the man begging at the entrance to the temple courts.

Over and over throughout the biblical account, we find that true prayer has to do with extraordinary encounters with God—encounters that align our hearts to God's heart. Encounters that move us toward people in need.
